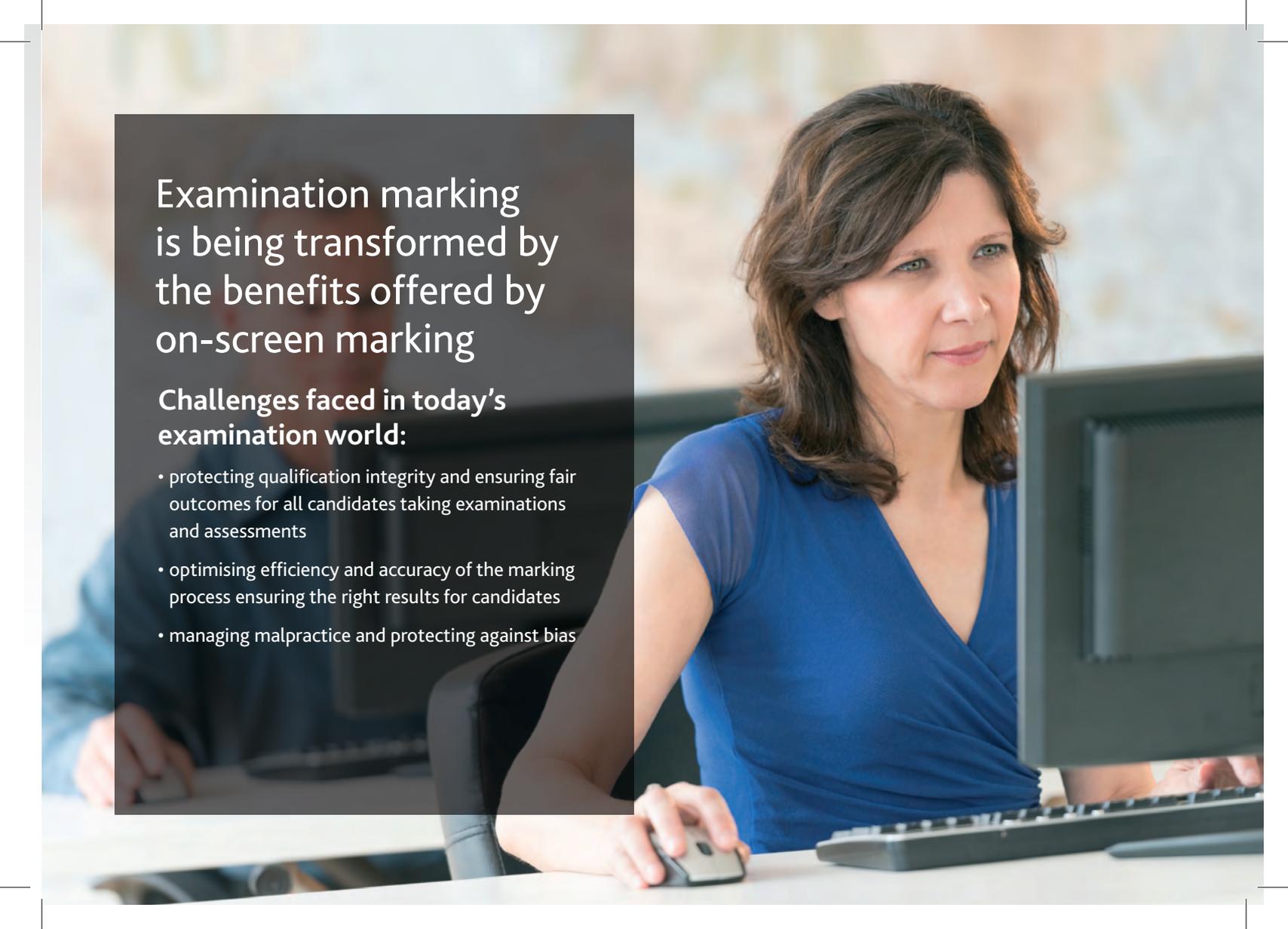

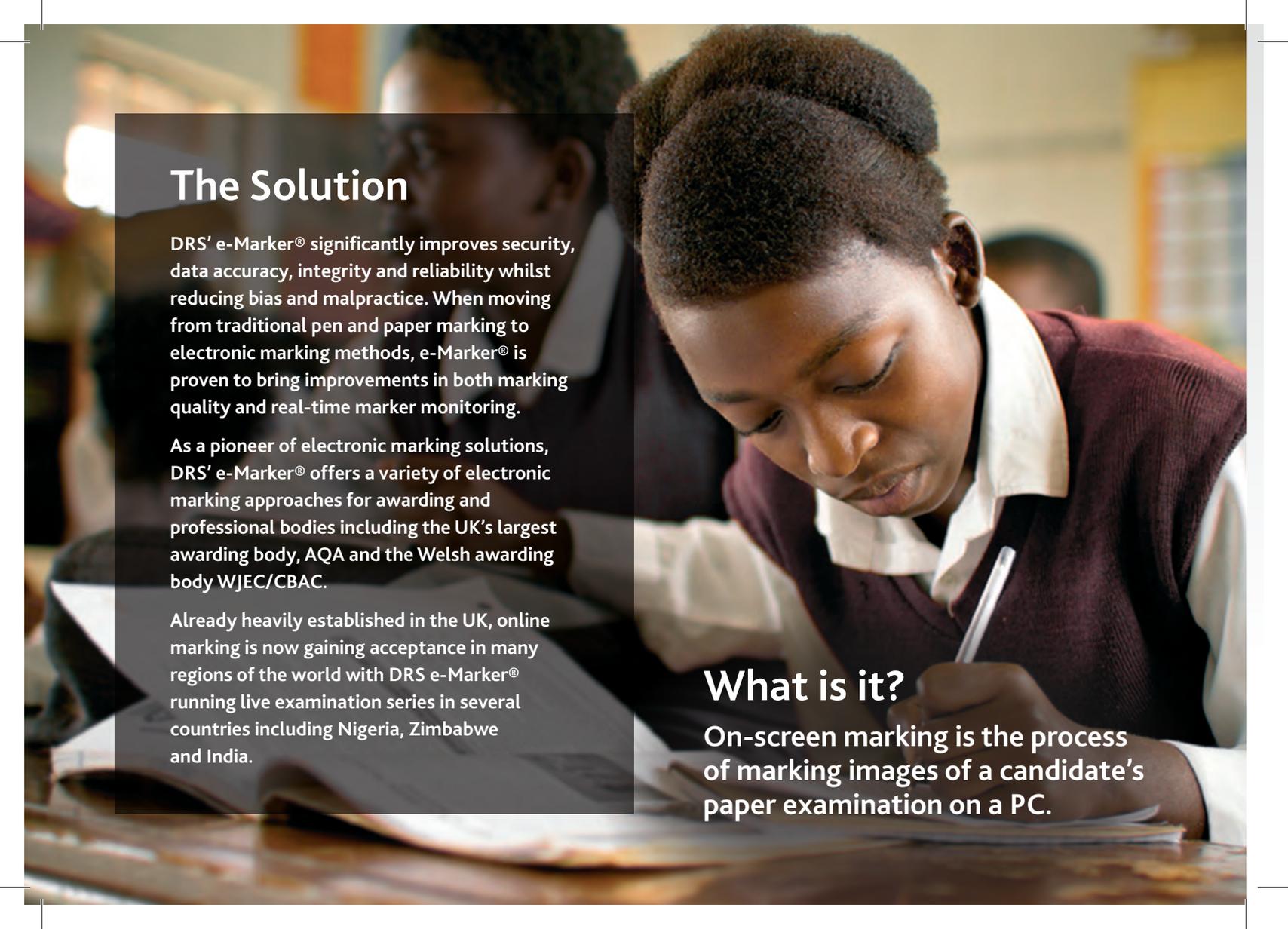

What is it?

On-screen marking is the process of marking images of a candidate's paper examination on a PC.

How does it work?

Candidate Answer Booklets are Scanned

Digital versions of all the pages are split into individual questions or groups of related questions known as segments.

Segments are Distributed to Markers

These segments are then distributed to different markers for marking using our specialist e-Marker® software. This is known as item level marking.

Markers Log into e-Marker®

They can do this at home or in marking centres and mark the number of questions allocated to them.

Quality Checks Throughout the Process

During their marking, quality checks are performed that verify that the marker is marking within the parameters outlined in the marking scheme guidance. Senior markers and awarding body staff can monitor the quality checks in real-time and take action if there is concern.

Real-time Management Information

e-Marker® enables the management and tracking at all stages of examination marking providing real-time information and vital reporting functions.

What types of assessments are supported?

Our item level on-screen marking solution supports various types of assessments, but most written tests fall into 2 categories:

- combined question and answer booklets where there is an area for a candidate to write their response
- separate question and answer booklet where a candidate writes in the blank answer booklet, writing the question number against their response

Our solution uses specialised software processes and techniques in order to segment both these types of assessments allowing e-Marker® to process the vast majority of written tests being taken around the world.
